If you have some time to stick around after the 10:30 service today please do to help put away the chairs and get all of the rooms ready for VBS.

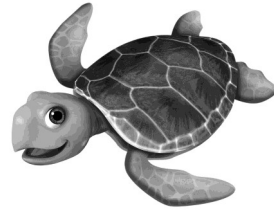


**Operation BRC!**

### VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL!

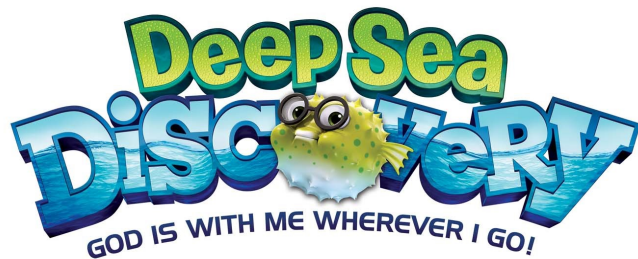
**Can you believe it, June is here! You know what that means, it is time for Vacation Bible School!**
