**Question 27.** What do you understand by the providence of God?

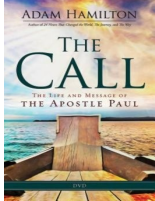

Our offering on 6/10/18 was \$5,300.00 towards the annual budget. Total weekly needed for budget is \$8452.00.



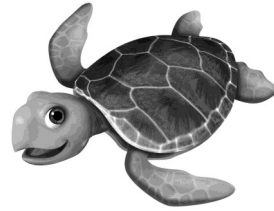
**Operation BRC!**

- 5) To increase the safety and security of our church family at our facility.

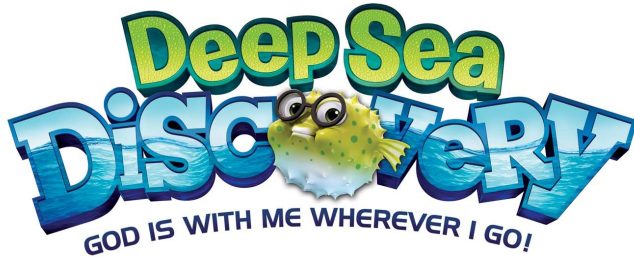
