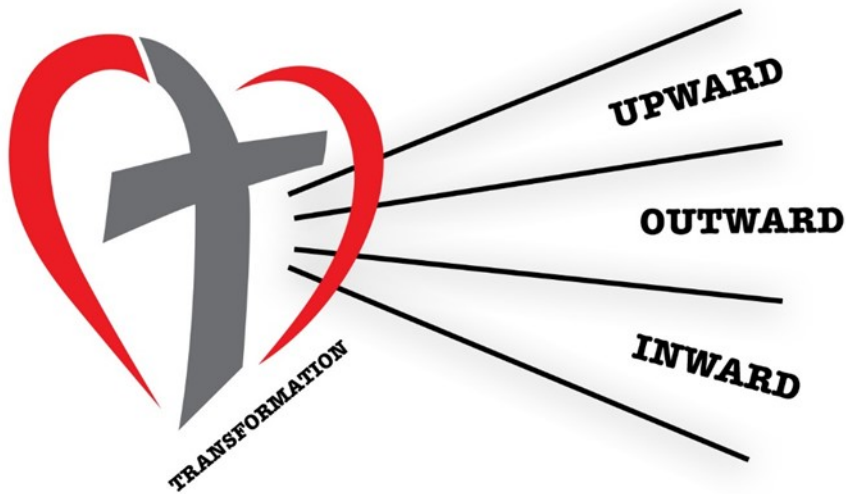

Heidelberg Catechism Question 112

What is God's will for you in the ninth commandment?

Answer. God's will is that I never give false testimony against anyone, twist no one's words, not gossip or slander, nor join in condemning anyone without a hearing or without a just cause.

Rather, in court and everywhere else, I should avoid lying and deceit of every kind; these are the very devices the devil himself uses, and they would call down on me God's intense anger.
