****About the campground:** there is a great swimming lake (there will be a certified lifeguard on duty), a basketball court, a volleyball court, horseshoe pits, a pool table inside, shade trees for relaxation, picnic tables, etc.

**Bring your own lawn chairs, bring life jackets for children under 10 if you want them near the water, and bring your sports equipment if you want to play. The Haynes family has asked that we do not bring any dogs.

Here are the directions to the campground: Take I-71 south of Brunswick to Exit 209; take 224 west toward Lodi; at the very first traffic light (County Rd 19) turn right and go .8 mile to Buffham Rd.; turn right and go to the end (1.4 miles) where it meets Ryan Rd; jog slightly left into the driveway (8385 Ryan Rd.), which will be clearly marked; take the twisting drive all the way back to the campground clearing. It will take you about 30 minutes from BRC.
