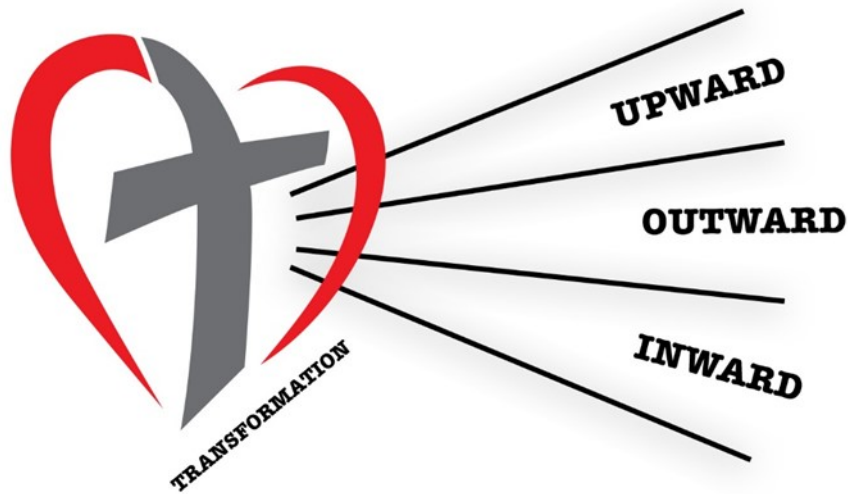

New City Catechism


Question 48. What is the church?
