Titus 2 Women's Bible Study...

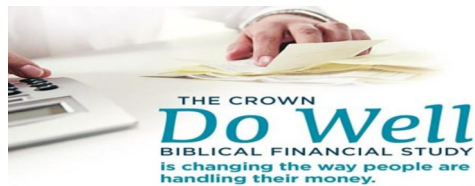
...equips women with godly advice - to support the younger women in the church. (Titus 2:3-5)
