Question 25. Does Christ's death mean all our sins can be forgiven?

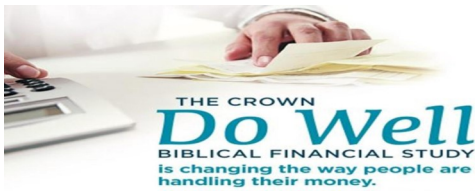

Currently studying THE DIFFERENCES Between Men and Women. The next 3 weeks will support Pastor Dan's message on INTIMACY.

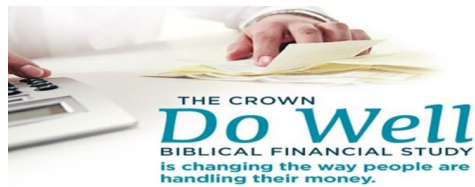
