Paul, Silas & Timothy were run out of town & a forced penalty tax was given in hopes that their message, their Christ, would be removed along w/ them!

But Christ is not bound, the gospel cannot be <u>silenced</u>, and the presence & purpose of the Church will not be removed from this world until Christ returns!

God had chosen a people to be His presence in Thessalonica! And God has chosen us, the people of BRC, to be His presence here in Brunswick as well.

This letter from the Apostle Paul to the Church in Thessalonica starts with affirmation that they were living into that which they were chosen for!

It was evident that the gospel was not only heard, but received w/ power!

Lives were changed! People turned from their idols & began to serve the true & living God - Vs. 9. This is what Holy Spirit power on display looks like!
