Heidelberg Catechism

Question 12. According to God's righteous judgment we deserve punishment both in this world and forever after: how then can we escape this punishment and return to God's favor?

Answer. God requires that his divine justice be satisfied. Therefore the claims of his justice must be paid in full, either by ourselves or by another.

Question 13. Can we pay this debt ourselves? **Answer.** Certainly not. Actually, we increase our guilt every day.

Question 14. Can another creature--any at all-- pay this debt for us? **Answer.** No. To begin with, God will not punish another creature for what a human is guilty of. Besides, no mere creature can bear the weight of God's eternal anger against sin and release others from it.

Question 15. What kind of mediator and deliverer should we look for then?

Answer. One who is truly human and truly righteous, yet more powerful than all creatures, that is, one who is also true God.
