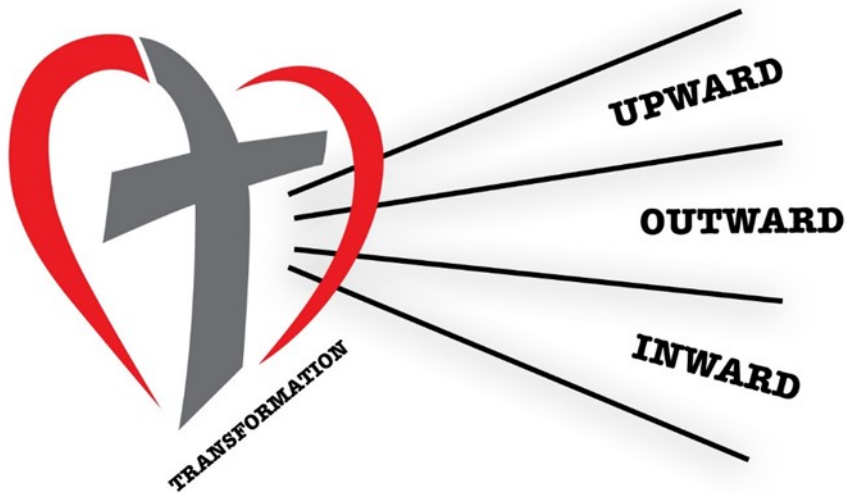

Give by Text

In less time than it takes to write a check, you can make weekly offerings or respond to special appeals by simply sending a text message from your smartphone.

Simply send a text to **330-239-8652** with the amount you would like to contribute. Make sure to include the dollar sign before the amount (example: \$25). Within a few minutes, you'll be sent a text with a link to register. Click on the link and enter your cardholder name and credit or debit card information. Once your registration is complete, you will receive a text verification and a receipt via email. For future giving, simply send a text with the amount you wish to give, and it will process automatically!

Use Give+ Church App

Search for “giveplus church” in your app store and download for free. You can give by credit card or bank account in the app.

Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) can set up a recurring donation, on whatever date, frequency, or bank account you choose. Link to sign up is on our website.

Weekly offering envelopes

Giving with check or cash to the funds you choose.

If you currently have envelopes and continue to want them, you don't have to do anything, we will order them for you. If you want to change to electronic giving, just let us know that you do not need envelopes next year. If you do not have envelopes but want them, please let us know to add you to the order. - 6. Do Not Feel Obligated to Give** - If you are a first-time guest, please do not feel obligated to participate in the offering. This is a time when members and regular attendees honor God by giving to his work through this church. Let today be our gift to you.

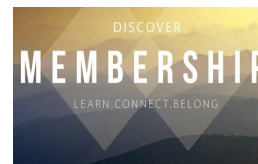
This man is hilarious! If you have never seen him perform you are in for a treat. Tickets are limited so buy soon if you want to go.
