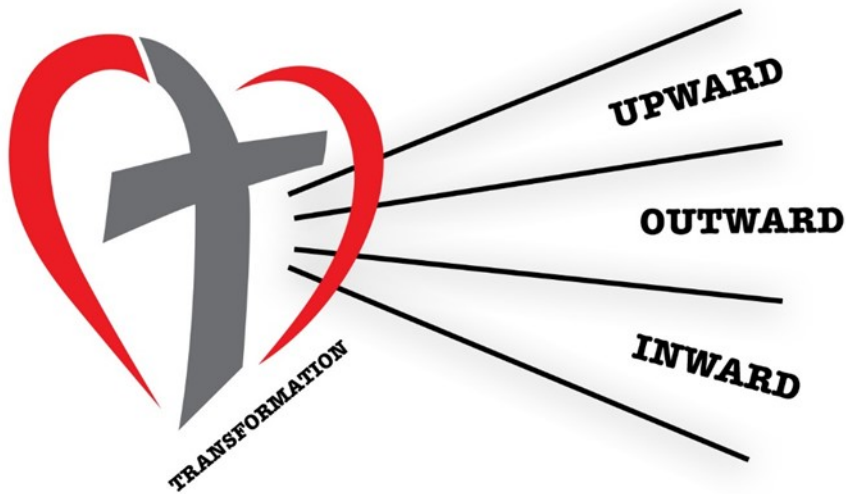

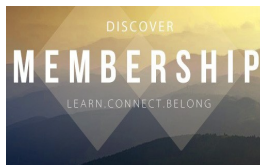
This man is hilarious! If you have never seen him perform you are in for a treat. Tickets are limited so buy soon if you want to go.
