Here is a little about what is going on there from Pastor Pete Pinkowski
Renew is going multisite: In the fall of 2020, we will be launching our
second campus in a first-tier suburban town of Cleveland called
Brooklyn. We were approached a little over a year ago about the
replanting via "death and resurrection" of Brooklyn Reformed
Church. Death and resurrection meaning closing the church for at least
a year and then relaunching with a new church....To put it bluntly, this
was not a part of Renew's plan, at least not a part of the plan with
Renew being still so young. We first said, "No, but thank you for
thinking of us." But a couple of days later God started to change the
hearts and minds of our leadership team. We started to pray and listen
more to the Spirit's leading and the long story short is six months later
Brooklyn Reformed Church closed and now we are in the process of
replanting Renew Brooklyn.

Transformation: One of the blessings that I have been able to be a part
of at Renew is watching and helping via the Spirit people be
transformed such as Lajuan. I have witnessed Lajuan a man who grew
up in the foster care system, came to know the Lord, walked with the
Lord, then in his 30's walked away from the Lord and eventually his
marriage, but God got a hold of him a couple years ago (don't you love
those but God stories) Now Lajuan is a man who is in love with God,
apologetics, foundations of the faith, one of the preachers at the church,
and is now married to a woman named Tia who also went through
Journey (Renew's leadership training).
