Question 123. What does the second request mean?

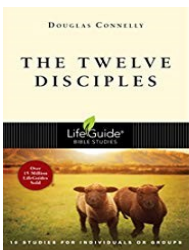

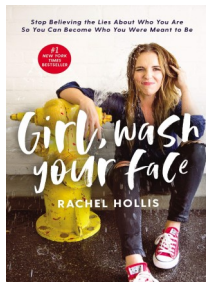
New small groups starting this month!
