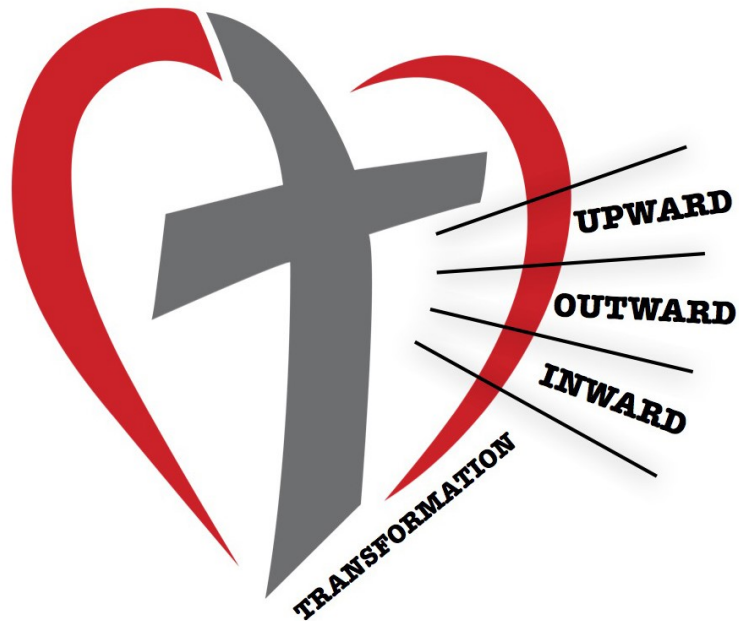

Heidelberg Catechism


Question 21. What is true faith?
