John 8:31-32 – "So Jesus said to the Jews who had believed him, 'If you abide in my word, you are truly my disciples, and you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free.'"

"you will know the truth..." What truth? We live in a day where everyone has their own version of truth. Is there even such a thing as absolute truth?

Truth is more than right information! Truth is not a what, it's <u>a who!</u> To know truth, is to abide in the words of Jesus, thus abiding in Jesus Himself!

"The Word became flesh & made His dwelling among us" – John 1:14.

Jesus said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life..." - John 14:6.

Jesus is the eternal Word of God who brings freedom because <u>He is Truth!</u>
And that Truth - "Jesus, is the same yesterday, today & forever" – Heb. 13:8

John 8:33-38 – They claimed that their status of being the offspring of Abraham was what ensured their freedom & justified their rejection of Jesus

Do we ever do that same thing today? Do we rely on our own <u>resumes</u>?

How would you answer this, "Do the words of Jesus find any place in you?" Sin has enslaved us – our minds/understanding/lives, yet Jesus offers these words of hope - "if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed." – Vs 36.

John 8:39-47 – Jesus basically says in this text, "Your resume is <u>not enough!</u>" Sin has separated you from God, freedom cannot be secured based upon anything in you, & you don't even belong to Abraham but belong to the devil.

Jesus says in *Matthew 12:30 – "Whoever is not with me is against me…"*So even though they were Abraham's seed, their rejection of Jesus as Lord & Savior left them with no place in the Kingdom of God! What about us?

What is on our <u>application</u> for Heaven? Would Jesus be one of our references?

"Whoever is of God hears the words of God"- Vs. 47. Do you hear His voice /His Word? Are you listening? Is the cry of your heart, "Speak O Lord"?

"If God were your Father, you would love me, for I came from God and I am here" – Vs. 42. Jesus is still here! He is alive today! Is He your truth? Is God your Father? Is freedom your song because you abide in Jesus Christ?
