

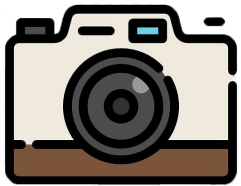
## Prayer Concerns

### Heidelberg Catechism

**Answer.** It is wholehearted joy in God through Christ and a delight to do every kind of good as God wants us to.
