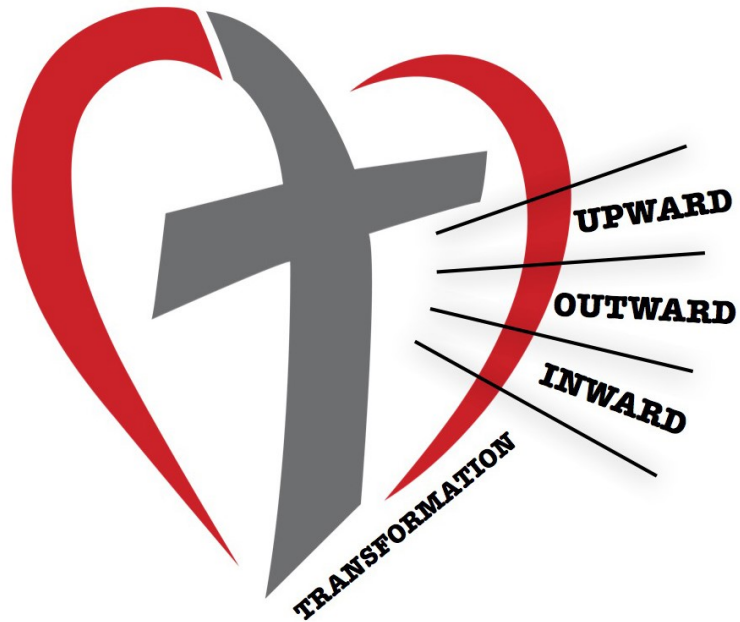

Heidelberg Catechism

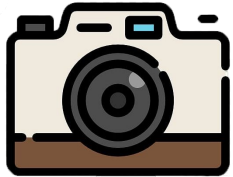
Question 1. What is your only comfort in life and in death?
