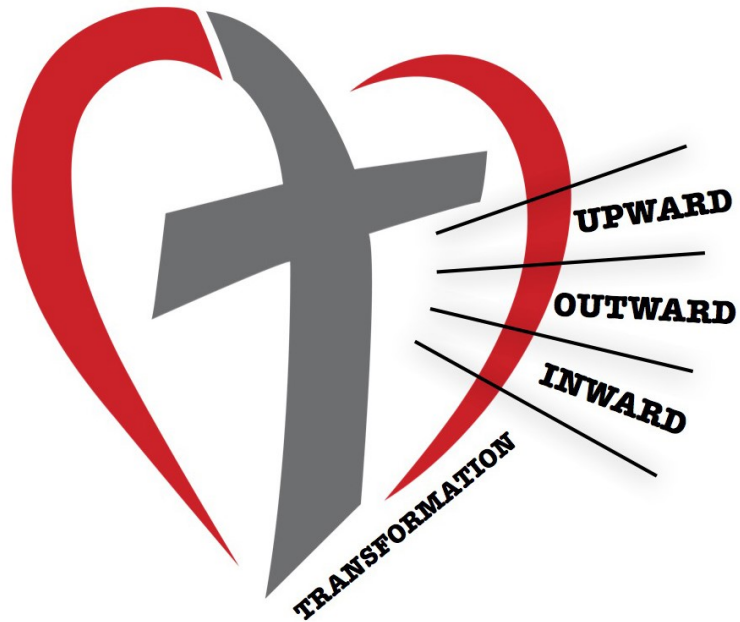

SERMON –BASED SMALL GROUP QUESTIONS

- 1) When people look at you what do they see? How do you see yourself? Do the people that you work with or your friends at school know you are a Christian by your actions and your words? Do people see Jesus when they see you?
- 2) How was it for you worshipping online for the last few months? If you have come back to church what have you experienced being back? If not do you notice something missing from your spiritual life?
- 3) This past week, was your delight in the Lord or in the things of this world? Did you do things through your strength or through God's strength? Did you trust God more than you trust yourself?
- 4) What is one practical way in which you can change your daily routines to rise up this week? How can your thoughts, actions, word, and heart be more like Jesus this week? Who can keep you accountable to make sure you rise up this week?
- 5) What is one thing that you or your family does to prepare yourself for worship each week? How do you transition from the chaos of normal life to the peace of church? If this is something that you struggle with, ask others in the group to give you some help.

Here is a brief rundown of times for the day:

*For those who would prefer to watch service online, there will be a video of the 9:30 service available to watch at 11am.

*While the picnic is free, there will be donation canisters available for those able to help defray the expenses.

****About the campground:** there is a great swimming lake (Please be advised-there will **NOT** be a lifeguard on duty), a basketball court, a volleyball court, horseshoe pits, a pool table inside, shade trees for relaxation, picnic tables, etc.

****Bring your own lawn chairs, bring life jackets for children under 10 if you want them near the water, and bring your sports equipment if you want to play. The Haynes family has asked that we do not bring any dogs.**

Directions to the campground:Take I-71 south of Brunswick to Exit 209; take 224 west toward Lodi; at the very first traffic light (County Rd 19) turn right and go .8 mile to Buffham Rd.; turn right and go to the end (1.4 miles) where it meets Ryan Rd; jog slightly left into the driveway (8385 Ryan Rd.), which will be clearly marked; take the twisting drive all the way back to the campground clearing. It's about 30 minutes from BRC.



Watch Party for “THE FEST” TODAY!

If you have never been to The Fest before, it is a fun afternoon of Christian music and we will add the fellowship part here at BRC (safely distant of course).

Our plan A (weather permitting) is to show the video outside on the screen, and play the audio through the FM transmitter like we did for the movie. We will also have the video and audio playing in the sanctuary (in its normal Sunday morning set up with distancing). We will have a large section of the parking lot sectioned off for families to bring blankets and lawn chairs to gather together and watch and listen in groups of 10 or less. You are welcome to come and go as you please, or you can stay the entire time. If you choose to come inside or stay inside we are still requiring masks and social distancing.

BRC will not be providing any food, but you are welcome to bring a picnic, leave and go get food and come back, or even order food to be delivered to the church. All food and drink (other than water) will need to be outside of the sanctuary. The side door to the sanctuary will be open, as well as the back door to use the back bathrooms. The playground will be open to kids as well. **Please do let us know on the Facebook event or by emailing myself or Michelle.**

If weather does not cooperate, we will have plans to be indoors.
