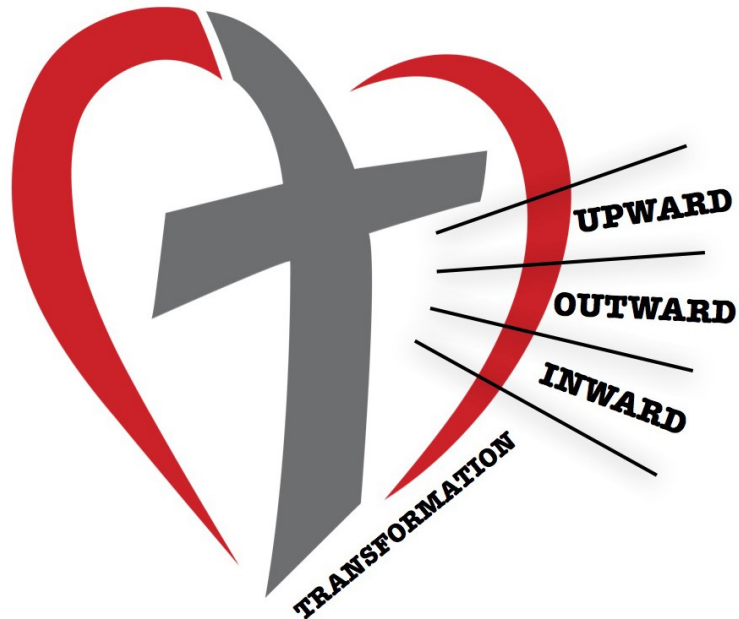

### Heidelberg Catechism

**Question 116.** Why do Christians need to pray?
