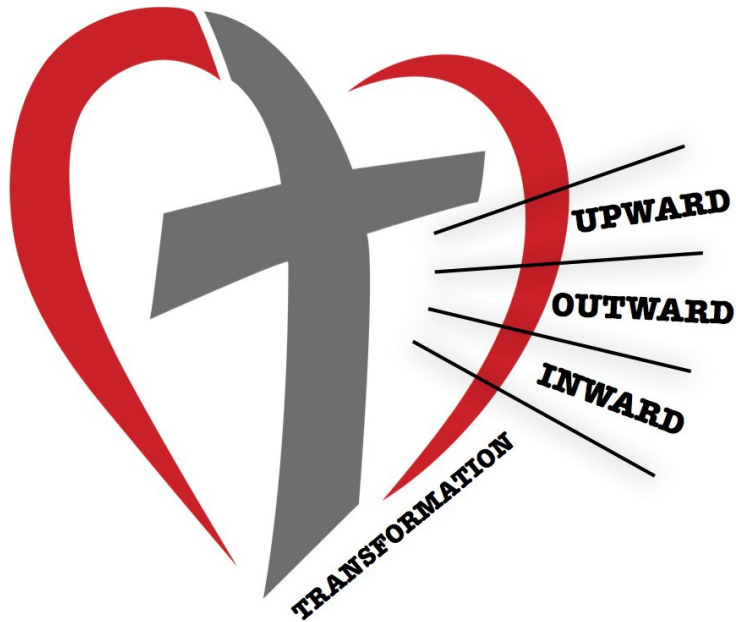

Psalm 32

- 3) How does being at peace with God affect the way you pursue being at peace with those around you (including yourself)?

- 5) What role has forgiveness played in your life? In your relationship with God and in your relationships with others?
- 6) Who do you need to forgive in your life? Who do you need to ask for forgiveness from?

Heidelberg Catechism

Question 126. What does the fifth request mean?

Answer. "Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors" means:

Because of Christ's blood, do not hold against us, poor sinners that we are, any of the sins we do or the evil that constantly clings to us. Forgive us just as we are fully determined, as evidence of your grace in us, to forgive our neighbors.
