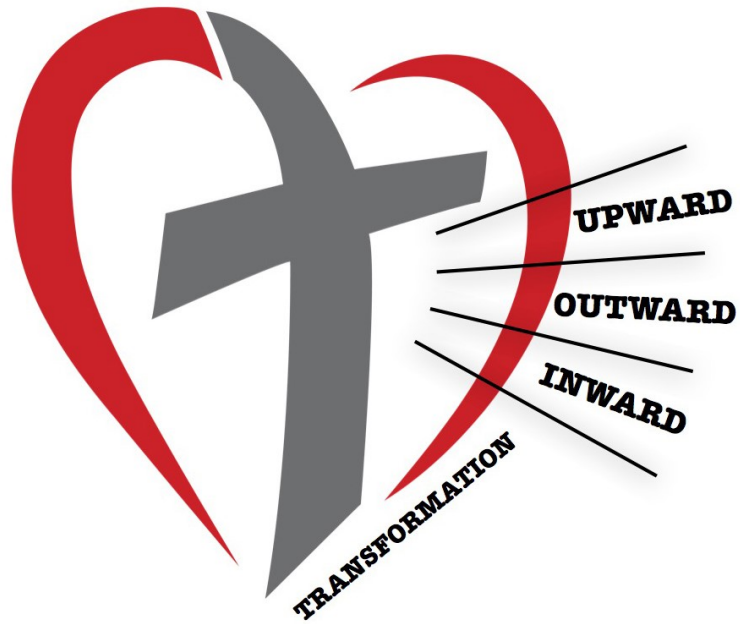

Operation Christmas Child 2020 Update

2020 has been a vastly different year from anything any of us have experienced in the past. There is one constant though to be sure, the need for BRC's Operation Christmas Child (OCC) Ministry to provide as many shoebox gifts and Gospel

Opportunity packets as possible to the extremely poor children of this world. This fall churches and organizations across the US that participate in Operation Christmas Child are having to do ministry different, but that does not have to mean less effective.

*BRC will NOT be having our typical packing party where the entire church is invited to join in filling hundreds of shoeboxes. The packing of 150 shoeboxes this year for 10-14-year-old boys will be handled with minimal volunteers. This is typically the group that has the lowest participation each year, so we felt it was important to focus on them. We are excited to be including soccer balls and pumps that can be shared with others. Thank you to our BRC Family and the church leadership for making the funds possible to purchase the items necessary.

*In addition to the 150 shoeboxes, we do believe this year provides an awesome opportunity for individuals, couples, and families to participate in greater numbers than we have seen in the past by:

1. **Packing boxes, yourself or as a family.** Go out, safely, and purchase items to pack as many shoeboxes as possible. BRC will have OCC boxes pre-made and ready for pickup 11/1 and drop off at BRC by 11/22. The boxes will include the label brochure and information on what to and not to include. Dollar Tree / Dollar General and Big Lots are excellent places to shop for items.

2. **Utilizing OCC's Build a Box Program.** For \$25 per box you can go to the special OCC site below, select the items you want to include in your box, and be notified of where your box will be delivered. This is an awesome way to participate from the comfort and safety of your own home.
