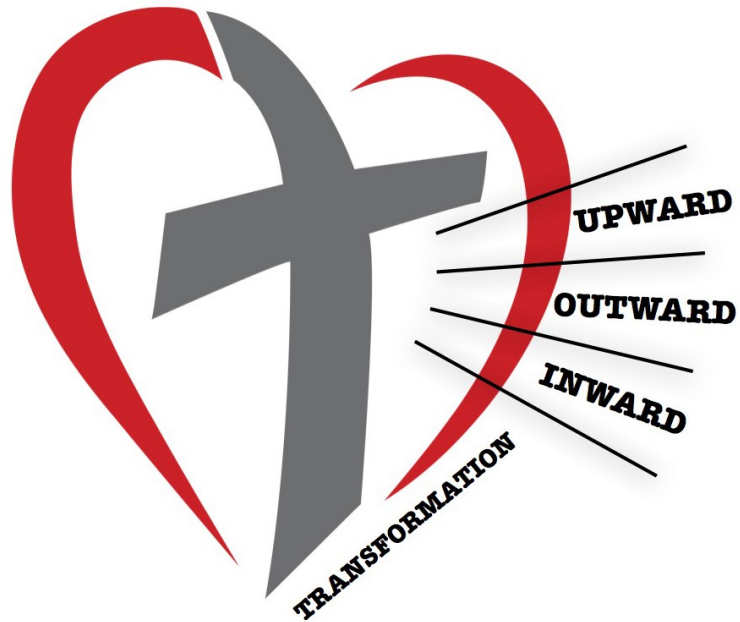

Remember our 2021 Connections Diagram? An example in the "Ministry/Service" piece is to "bless someone" so that is what we are going to do!

We decided to put a twist on our Easter Egg hunt. Families attending our Easter Egg Hunt and our youth group will be provided with 12 extra stuffed eggs (one empty to emphasize the resurrection) and we invite you to "egg" someone's house in your neighborhood. "Egged" meaning—hide the 12 eggs in their front yard and place the "you've been egged" sign somewhere visible. The sign explains the eggs.

We are excited about this opportunity, and if anyone in our congregation wants to also participate in this with us, we can provide you with the sign to put in the yard, we just ask you to provide the stuffed eggs - we've already maxed out our 800+ eggs. If you would like a sign, please let Michelle know to make one for you.
