

Heidelberg Catechism

Question 54. What do you believe concerning "the holy catholic church"?

Answer. I believe that the Son of God through his Spirit and Word, out of the entire human race, from the beginning of the world to its end, gathers, protects, and preserves for himself a community chosen for eternal life and united in true faith. And of this community I am and always will be a living member.

Liturgy of Rededication

(adapted from the 1961, 1981, 1991, & 2001 dedication of the building)

Minister: To the glory of God the Father, to the honor of Jesus Christ His only begotten Son our Savior and to the praise of the Holy Spirit our Comforter,

Congregation: ***We rededicate this house.***

Minister: In memory of that great company of Christian saints, apostles, martyrs, and humble souls who through the ages have been partakers of His grace and who now stand about us now as a great cloud of witnesses,

Congregation: ***We rededicate this house.***

Minister: For worship in prayer and praise; for the preaching and teaching of the word of God, and for the celebration of the Holy Sacraments,

Congregation: ***We rededicate this house.***

Minister: For comfort to those who mourn; healing to those who are hurting, for strength to those who are weak; for help to those who are tempted, for the forgiveness of sins for all of us sinners, and for a connection with God to all who are searching,

Congregation: ***We rededicate this house.***

Minister: For the sanctity of the family; for those who stand here in the solemn vows of sacred marriage; for the baptism, guidance, and purity of our children; and for the inspiration of the young and the joy of the old,

Congregation: ***We rededicate this house.***

Minister: To be a place where the people of God can engage in the ministry of Christ's Church and the mission of God's Kingdom here on earth,

Congregation: ***We rededicate this house.***

Minister: These are all excellent purposes, but how will we achieve them?

Congregation: ***We must rededicate ourselves to the Lord.***

Minister: To seek the Lord in prayer, in His Word, in worship, and in each other,

Congregation: ***We rededicate ourselves to the Lord.***

Minister: To be a gracious and sensitive people, to be forgiving and accepting, to be open to all the ways we will have opportunity to minister to those inside and outside of the family of God,

Congregation: ***We rededicate ourselves to the Lord.***

Minister: In Christ, God has already declared us to be a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people set apart onto Himself. Therefore, in response to this,

Congregation: ***We rededicate ourselves to the Lord.***

Minister: Do we then accept the opportunity and responsibility of rededicating this house of worship, and ourselves, to the service of God and His Kingdom?

Congregation: **Before God and one another, and calling upon the Holy Spirit for help, we do.**

Minister: And all of God's people said,

Unison: ***Amen!***
