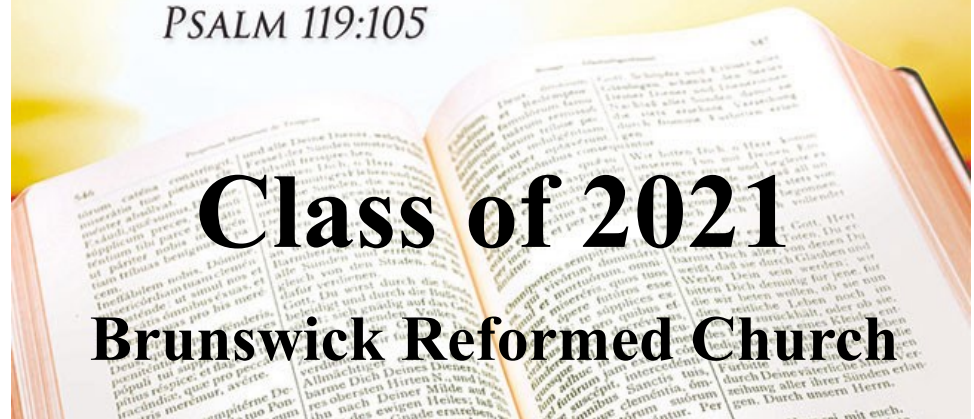

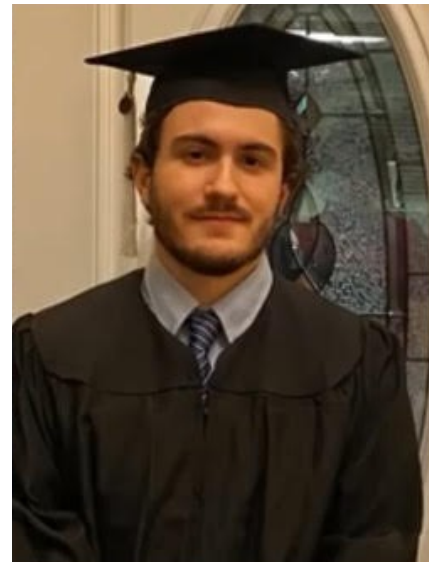
will use this as a learning and guidance tool for her future teaching career.

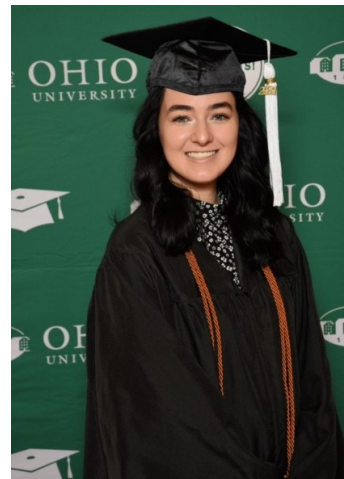


**Joe Garapic
