The church offices will be closed December 27th through January 2nd.

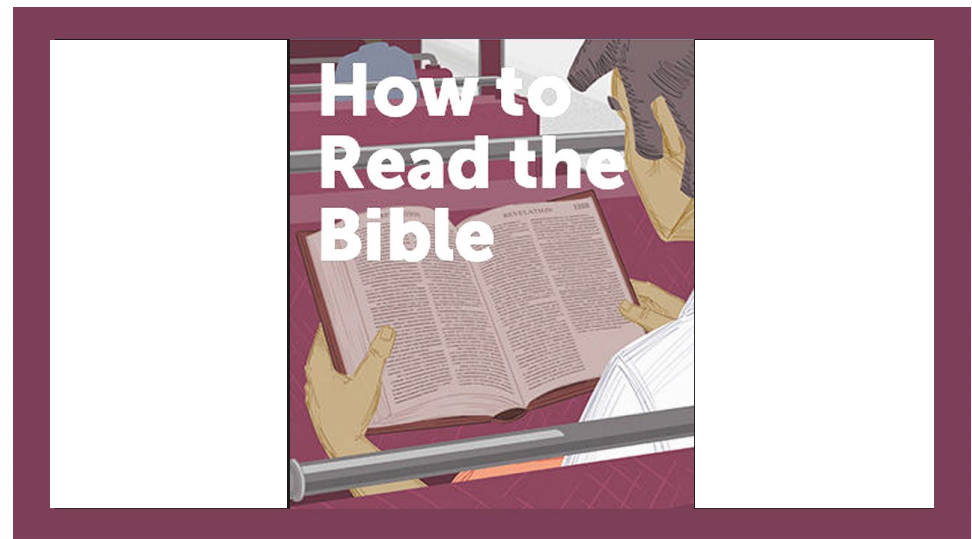
