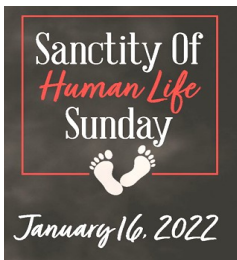

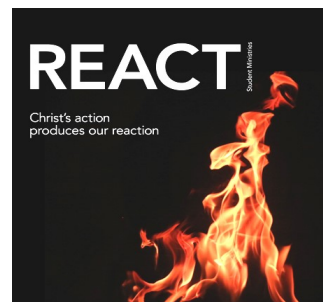
We will be installing our new Deacons and Elders next Sunday January 16th.

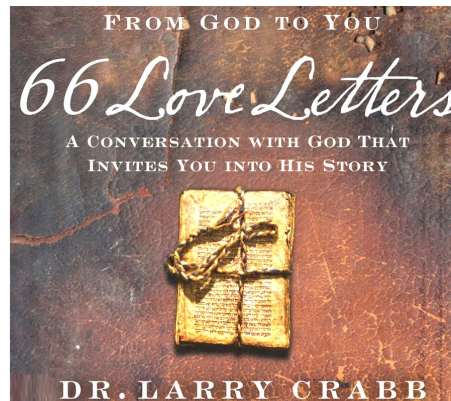
Youth Group Game Night online
