

Heidelberg Catechism

Question 10. Will God permit such disobedience and rebellion to go unpunished?

Answer. Certainly not. God is terribly angry about the sin we are born with as well as the sins we personally commit. As a just judge God punishes them now and in eternity. He has declared: "Cursed is everyone who does not continue to do everything written in the Book of the Law."

Question 11. But isn't God also merciful?

Answer. God is certainly merciful, but he is also just. His justice demands that sin, committed against his supreme majesty, be punished with the supreme penalty-- eternal punishment of body and soul.






*Are you enjoying Pastor Dan's sermon series?
