Due to the tragic events that have developed in Ukraine, tens of thousands, perhaps millions will be gravely affected, including the 150,000 Hungarians living in the Subcarpathian region of Ukraine. In Ukraine we are witnessing destruction, suffering, and death. Let us diligently pray that this war comes to an end, peace returns to the region, and innocent human lives, be it Ukrainian, Hungarian-Ukrainian, or Russian are spared.

In addition to our prayers, they are in need of financial support. There is a refugee crisis developing on both sides of the Ukrainian-Hungarian border. Both Hungarian-Ukrainians and Ukrainians need our help.
