Ezra 1 – "Are you kidding me?!?"

Cyrus, king of Persia, king & conqueror of the known world, <u>submits</u> himself under the authority & command of the God of Israel!

- Prophecies spoken from 3 different prophets (Isaiah, Jeremiah, Daniel),
 Isaiah's spoken over a century before, are being fulfilled in Cyrus' decree!
- God's people were not only allowed to return to Jerusalem to rebuild the temple, they were also given all the supplies needed from their <u>neighbors</u>!
- All the spoils of war, that were taken from the temple when is was destroyed by Babylon, are returned to God's people by king Cyrus!

If it's hard for us to believe at times that our God can do "<u>immeasurably</u> more than we could ever ask or imagine", remember this story!

It's more than just words we sing in a song, it is an eternal truth - "Forever God is faithful, forever God is strong, forever God is with us, forever!"

That doesn't mean life will be easy! It doesn't mean things will always work according to our timetable! It doesn't even mean that we will be able to see & understand God's faithfulness in the moment, but He is faithful – forever!

Ezra 3:1-4 – Vs. 1 - "The people gathered as <u>one</u> man to Jerusalem."

What a beautiful thing, when the people of God are united, and one, in purpose, in hope, and in living in response to the faithfulness of God!

It's been said, "There is nothing like being a part of <u>the Church</u>, when the church is functioning rightly!" That is so true – & this is a great example.

But the function of God's people is so much more than just building a structure for worship, it is to be a people that bring glory to God in all of life!

Rebuilding the temple did bring glory to God, but it was never intended to stop there! God wanted to rebuild His people, in keeping with His covenant promise!

God's solution to rebuild His people, was the raising up & sending of <u>Ezral</u> In this book that bears his name, Ezra doesn't show up until chapter 7 of 10!

Ezra – "He was a scribe skilled in the Law of Moses that the Lord, the God of Israel, had given, and the king granted him all that he asked, for the hand of the Lord his God was on him."

Ch. 7 Vs. 10 – "For Ezra had set his heart to study the Law of the Lord, and to do it and to teach his (God's) statutes and rules in Israel."

This was the greatest work of rebuilding that needed to be done in Israel after the exile, and it's also true of the Church we are all a part of today!

Building programs are exciting, and we get to see immediate & tangible results! The work of <u>discipleship</u>, on the other hand, is a long & tedious process that involves much pruning before the evidence of good fruit is ever seen!

Ezra was the leader God used to move God's people from just focusing on the good work of rebuilding the temple, to an even better work of spiritual growth!
