Due to the tragic events that have developed in Ukraine, tens of thousands, perhaps millions will be gravely affected, including the 150,000 Hungarians living in the Subcarpathian region of Ukraine. 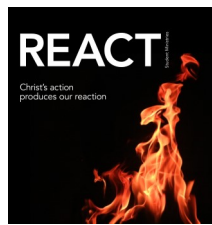
