

Saturday May 21st will be our outdoor Spring Clean Up starting at 9:00am. If you would like to volunteer to help, here is a list of what projects we have for the day. Please bring shovels and rakes if you have them. Thanks!

Spring Clean up 2022

- Clean out leaves and weed all flower beds including the rose flower beds and around our church sign and the areas in the parking lot
- Cut back all spring flowers that have bloomed
- Bring out the hoses and attach
- Need 95 bags of brown much delivered and spread
- If possible, divide some of the day lilies and Russian sage and replant in different areas.
- Clean up around the new shed and rake and smooth the ground around it.
- Weed the playground (possibly add mulch in the playground)
- Trim tree branches in parking lot to make sure cars don't hit the branches
- Trim tree branches around light fixtures
- Rake leaves and pick up trash on far side of the fence
- Level out divits of dirt between parking lot and playground
- Blow out leaves from gutters
- Adjust/realign parking stumps
