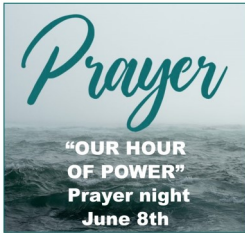

Heidelberg Catechism

Question 122. What does the first request mean?

Answer. "Hallowed be your name" means:
