Who Is BRC? We are a member of the Reformed Church in America, a Protestant denomination that goes back to the Reformation period in Europe when the Church was "reformed" according to the Word of God. We are a mixture of Christians from many denominational backgrounds, all seeking to grow in our spiritual maturity as we live by faith with Jesus as our forgiver and leader.

This whole year, BRC has decided to support a missionary family that is headed over to the Middle East to set up a school for missionaries to learn how to evangelize to people who are Islamic. Here are 4 ways you can be praying for them:

How Can You Pray with Us?

1. Pray that our transition into the country is smooth—and pray that when it's not, we have patience and grace. There are always logistical hurdles going into a new country, whether it is obtaining visas, finding the right housing, getting vehicles, or opening bank accounts. Inevitably some of those tasks will take longer than we are told. In those instances, we will need to be patient and gracious.
2. Pray for good relationships to develop and form within the communities of the UAE and the wider Arabian Peninsula. While we are not new to the Arabian Peninsula, we by no means know every person's story or every church's story. We want to get to know church leaders so we can understand how we can best support them.
3. Pray for all of us as we find a new community. Being in a new place means finding new friends, and that is usually the biggest fear that kids have, including our own. We are confident that they will make friends quickly once they start school.
4. Pray for Alison and the kids and she starts teaching again, and the kids transition to a new school.

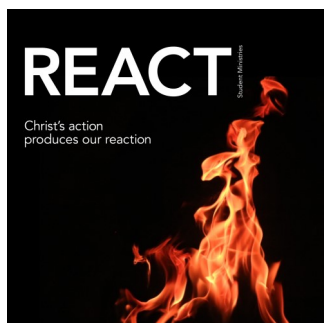
