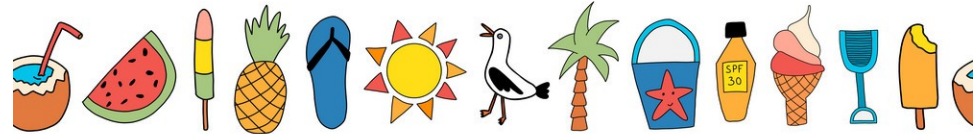

## The Belgic Confession

### Article 28: The Obligations of Church Members

We believe that,  
since this holy assembly and congregation  
is the gathering of those who are saved  
and there is no salvation apart from it,  
no one ought to withdraw from it,  
content to be by himself,  
regardless of his status or condition.

But all people are obliged  
to join and unite with it,  
keeping the unity of the church  
by submitting to its instruction and discipline,  
by bending their necks under the yoke of Jesus Christ,  
and by serving to build up one another,  
according to the gifts God has given them  
as members of each other  
in the same body.

**Directions to the campground:** Take I-71 south of Brunswick to Exit 209; take 224 west toward Lodi; at the very first traffic light (County Rd 19) turn right and go .8 mile to Buffham Rd.; turn right and go to the end (1.4 miles) where it meets Ryan Rd; jog slightly left into the driveway (8385 Ryan Rd.), which will be clearly marked; take the twisting drive all the way back to the campground clearing. It's about 30 minutes from BRC.
