Cut back: Roses, hydrangeas, hostas

Cut back to 3 inches above ground: day lilies, Russian sage, daisies, ornamental grass

Pull out annuals

Do **not** trim butterfly bushes

Cut back plants around the church sign

Trim Trees around parking lot lights: Both by mission house and evergreens along the back row
