

Donations of lights and extension cords help support the Cleveland Metroparks Zoo's conservation efforts for lion and cheetahs. Donated lights and extension cords will be recycled and useful metals repurposed. All proceeds from this metal

repurposing are donated to the Zoo's Future for Wildlife partner Lion Landscapes. In 2021, Ruaha Carnivore Project and Lion Landscapes joined forces in an effort to build more collaborative conservation. Under the new, combined organization name of Lion Landscapes, researchers and scientists work in key landscapes of Tanzania, Kenya, and Zambia to conserve lion populations and other large carnivores. Their mission is to achieve successful human carnivore coexistence by empowering local communities, and to develop effective strategies for long term carnivore conservation. They aim to reduce the costs and improve the benefits associated with wildlife, particularly carnivores, on village land, and directly engage and empower local people in conservation. 
