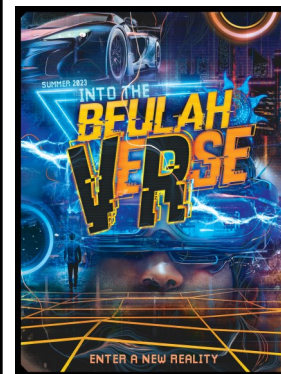

Heidelberg Catechism

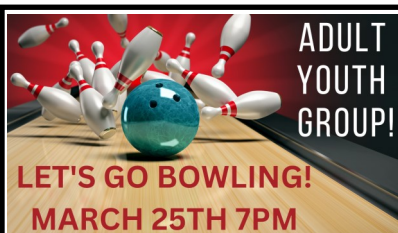
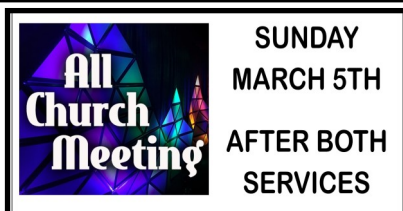

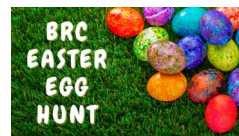

BRUNSWICK FOOD PANTRY & PERSONAL CARE PANTRY

March's Mission Minded Initiative is to support both the Brunswick Food Pantry and the Brunswick Personal Care Pantry. The Food Pantry is a 100% volunteer run organization funded by donations only

serving the residents of Brunswick, Brunswick Hills, Hinckley and Valley City. They provide a three-day emergency supply of food (based on household size) to eligible families once each calendar month.

There are two Personal Care Pantries in Brunswick-on at the Church of the Nazarene and one at Faithwalk Church. If you want to volunteer, the Church of the Nazarene could use some extra hands on Thursday March 23rd from 5:45 - 7:30pm.
