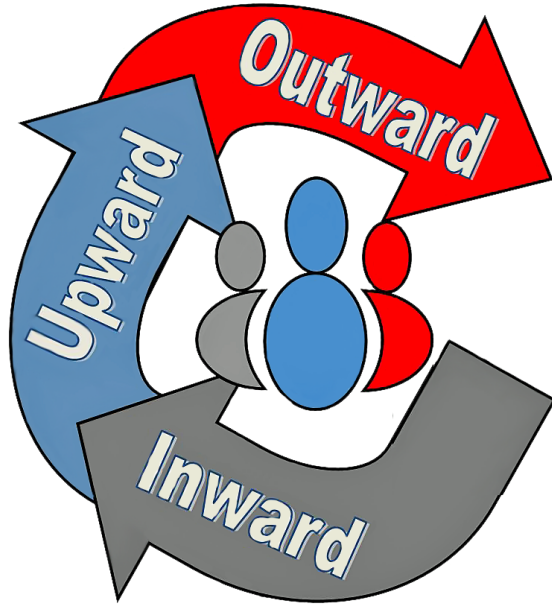

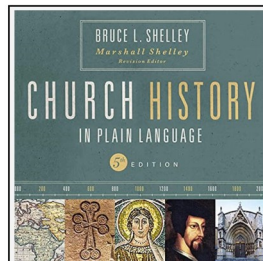

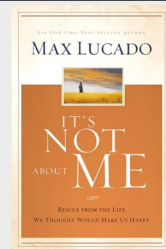

March's Mission Minded Initiative is to support both the Brunswick Food Pantry and the Brunswick Personal Care Pantry.

The Food Pantry is a 100% volunteer run organization funded by donations only

serving the residents of Brunswick, Brunswick Hills, Hinckley and Valley City. They provide a three-day emergency supply of food (based on household size) to eligible families once each calendar month.

There are two Personal Care Pantries in Brunswick-on at the Church of the Nazarene and one at Faithwalk Church. Let's really come together for those in need in our community, and help our brothers and sisters in Christ at the same time!
