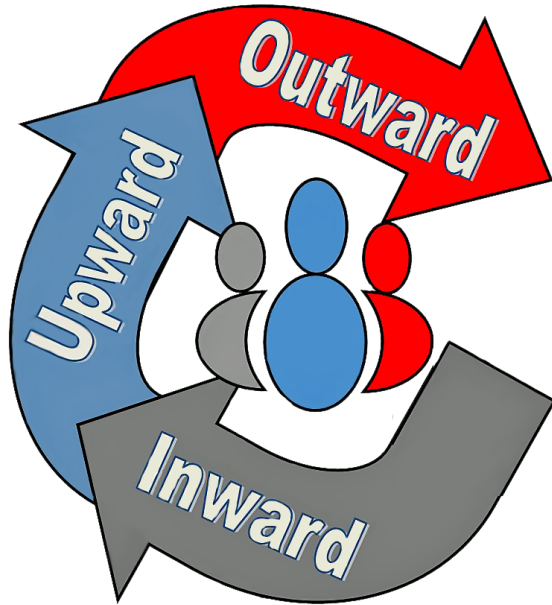

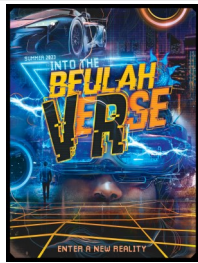
Our offering for 5/7/23 was \$9,283.26 towards the annual budget.

Spring Clean up Job List

- Prep the playground area for mulch.
- Clean leaves and debris from all flower beds including the areas in the parking lot.
- Weed the beds!
- Cut daffodils back.
- Connect all hoses.
- Straighten out tree in the front of the church.
- Cut back limbs on low hanging trees.
- Clean out the bed by the sign.
- Clean up sticks by the back tree line.
- Move the piles of wood from the back tree line.
- Rake up extra grass
- Spray weed killer in the parking lot where grass is growing through the pavement
- Edging along the sidewalks
- Rototill dirt east side of shed
