Jesus was about to graduate from this earthly life, but He had one more final exam – the cross. But what was to come after? Resurrection, ascension, and a heavenly reception where He would receive all glory, honor & praise!

So too, had Jesus labored for 3 years to meet all the requirements of His graduation day, when His work here on earth would be finished. He not only finished well, He also graduated valedictorian with the highest honors!

If Jesus had the opportunity to give that speech at His graduation, I believe John 17 would be it - A prayer to His Father, on behalf of His followers!

"Father, the hour has come; glorify your Son that the Son may glorify you..."
