Calling all Ladies! The Titus 2 Women's Bible Study is excited to kick off a Bible Reading Campaign we're calling "Women in Wisdom!"

For the month of July, we will be independently reading through the book of Proverbs. Just like there are 31 days in July, there are 31 chapters in Proverbs. You'll read one chapter each day and find just one cross-reference verse in the New Testament.

Once you've found your cross-reference verse, share it and one of your favorite proverbs from that day's chapter to our Titus 2 Facebook group page for one entry to the contest. Q: What is a Biblical Cross Reference?

A. It is a verse or passage of scripture that relates to another, and there are over 63,000 of them in the Bible!

Here is an example of one for you:

Old Testament:

Proverbs 3:1: My son, do not forget my teaching, but let your heart keep my commandments.

New Testament cross reference:

John 14:21: Whoever has my commandments and keeps them, he it is who loves me. And he who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I will love him and manifest myself to him.

Q: How do I find a cross reference?

A: If you don't know of one, you can use a Bible Concordance to search by topic. If you don't have a hard copy of a Bible Concordance, one is available online through BibleHub.net.

Q: Do I have to attend a Titus class to participate in the contest?

A. While we'd love to have you join us in one of our classes (Mondays at 6:30 pm or Wednesdays at 9:30 am) attendance is not mandatory. We hope you all will join us!

Heidelberg Catechism

Question 103. What is God's will for you in the fourth commandment?

Answer. First, that the gospel ministry and education for it be maintained, and that, especially on the festive day of rest, I regularly attend the assembly of God's people to learn what God's Word teaches, to participate in the sacraments, to pray to God publicly, and to bring Christian offerings for the poor.

Second, that every day of my life I rest from my evil ways, let the Lord work in me through his Spirit, and so begin already in this life the eternal Sabbath.
