Heidelberg Catechism

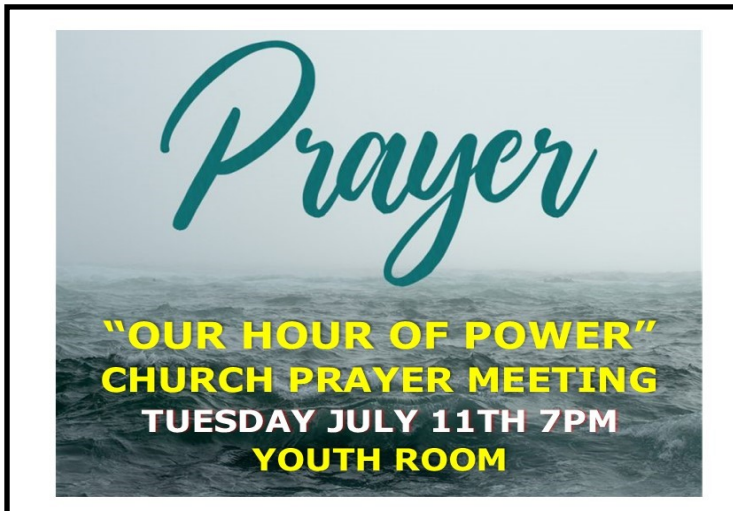
