How can my righteousness exceed that of the Pharisees?

What is righteousness?

Righteousness is one of God's most prominent attributes, where in all cases God always acts in morally and ethically right ways.

Because He is perfect and holy, He cannot act any other way.

The Pharisees and religious leaders were merely self-righteous

Human beings have no righteousness of their own. We are sinful by nature and there is nothing we can do to make ourselves righteous.

Isaiah 64:6 All of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous acts are like <u>filthy rags;</u> we all shrivel up like a leaf, and like the wind our sins sweep us away.

2 Corinthians 5:21

Our sin is exchanged for the righteousness of Christ. The righteousness of Christ must be <u>imputed</u> to us

Romans 4:3

Murder

²¹ "You have heard that it was said to the people long ago, 'You shall not murder, and anyone who murders will be subject to judgment.' ²² But I tell you that anyone who is angry with a brother or sister will be subject to judgment. Again, anyone who says to a brother or sister, 'Raca,' is answerable to the court. And anyone who says, 'You fool!' will be in danger of the fire of hell.
