Our church picnic will be from noon-4 at the Haynes family campground in Seville. The church will provide hamburgers and hot dogs, and we ask each family to bring either a salad, a side dish, or a dessert to share. That is always a great day of fun and fellowship, and we will also be celebrating at least 3 baptisms in the lake.

****About the campground:** there is a great swimming lake (Please be advised-there will **NOT** be a lifeguard on duty), a pool table inside, shade trees for relaxation, picnic tables, etc.

**Bring your own lawn chairs, bring life jackets for children under 10 if you want them near the water, and bring your sports equipment if you want to play. The Haynes family has asked that we do not bring any dogs.

Directions to the campground: Take I-71 south of Brunswick to Exit 209; take 224 west toward Lodi; at the very first traffic light (County Rd 19) turn right and go .8 mile to Buffham Rd.; turn right and go to the end (1.4 miles) where it meets Ryan Rd; jog slightly left into the driveway (8385 Ryan Rd.), which will be clearly marked; take the twisting drive all the way back to the campground clearing. It's about 30 minutes from BRC.



Our Mission Minded Focus for August is **That Place for Teens** here in Brunswick. They are a non-denominational organization that is trying to meet the unique needs of teens and their families by demonstrating the love of Christ.

A Brief History of Bells at BRC:

In 1981, 2 octaves of 24 Schulmerich bells arrived at BRC. In 1984, a 3rd octave was purchased. Much of the other equipment was donated. In 1999, a 4th octave was purchased. The choir played for BRC worship services and

traveled to other churches and played at other events over a 5 state area. In 2001, 4 octaves of chimes were donated.

The Ring and Rejoice handbell choir uses the 48 bells and 48 chimes to bring honor and glory to God through the use of these instruments.

The American Guild of Handbells considers this ministry "a musical art form."
