Jesus experienced all these things in the flesh! One evidence of being human, is to be a person who exists in time! Jesus met that requirement!

But Jesus is more than just a person in time, He also exists outside of time! Let me share a couple Scriptures that reveal this truth:

- 1) John 1:1-4, 14 Jesus is the eternal "Word", that was with God in the beginning... before space & time even existed!
- 2) 1 Peter 1:19-20 Jesus was known as the lamb to be slain before the foundation of the world. Jesus' purpose was ordained before time!
- 3) Revelation 1:8; 22:13 Jesus is the ever existing One! Not only is He present at the beginning and the end, He is the beginning & the end!

Jesus existed in time, and yet He is not bound by it! Why does that matter?

- Jesus' life, death, and resurrection was more than just a historical event, it is the very <u>focal point</u> of all of history! Our very dating system, the way we record time itself, declares the significance of Jesus' earthly life!
- Jesus' life is so much more than just a grain of sand on the timeline of history! He exists in infinity (past & future), so no matter where we exist on the timeline, God is with us in Christ (in His divinity)!
- Since Jesus is outside of time, He not only exists at all times but He's also active, accomplishing His <u>redemptive</u> purposes, at every point in time!

I don't know if that makes you as excited as it makes me, but it should!
