#### From Alexa:

In 2022, I became convicted of the fact that I had never read the Bible cover to cover, so I took on the challenge for the first time.

Before that, my engagement with God's word was limited to Sunday mornings at church and occasional readings during the week when I had questions or was part of a study. I realized I had been treating The Bible more like a self-help book, neglecting its profound significance as the very word of God given to us.

As someone who has identified as a Christian throughout my entire life, this was something I needed to change. Reading through the Bible in a year has been a transformative experience, and I'm eagerly looking forward to doing it again this year.

The Titus 2 women are launching a "Through the Bible in a Year" campaign. Whether you're like me—a cradle Christian who never took the time to read it through—or like Annette, who has done it every year since 2015—we invite you to join us!

We'll be following the Daily Audio Bible reading plan, requiring just around 15-25 minutes each day, depending on your reading speed. 
