If you wish to help, there is a box on the shelf across from the kitchen at BRC to recycle your Christmas lights and extension cords. They will be collecting until February.





Heidelberg Catechism

Question 6. Did God create people so wicked and perverse?

Answer. No. God created them good and in his own image, that is, in true righteousness and holiness, so that they might truly know God their creator, love him with all their heart, and live with him in eternal happiness for God's praise and glory.

Question 7. Then where does this corrupt human nature come from?
