Sermon Title: God is Sovereign

Sermon Text: Psalm 135

How are we doing with our Scripture memory? Psalm 119:97-105

- God is <u>Incomprehensible</u> Romans 11:33 "Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable are his judgments, and his paths beyond tracing out!"
- God is <u>Known</u> John 17:3 "And this is eternal life, that they know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you sent."
- God is <u>Transcendent</u> <u>Psalm 113:4-5</u> "The Lord is high above all nations, and his glory above the heavens! Who is like the Lord our God, who is seated on high."
- God is <u>Immanent</u> <u>Psalm 139:1 "O Lord, you have searched me and known me!"</u>
- God is <u>Sovereign</u> <u>Romans 11:36</u> "For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever. Amen."

Psalm 119:111 – "Your testimonies are my heritage forever, for they are the joy of my heart."

Do we agree with that statement? Any evidence?

Westminster Confession of Faith Shorter Catechism Q #1– What is the chief end of man? Man's chief end is to glorify God and enjoy Him forever!

It's easy to glorify and enjoy a God who is Incomprehensible... Known...

Transcendent... and Immanent... But what about a God who is sovereign?

A God who is sovereign, is a God who is in control... who is responsible for everything that comes to pass... who gives & takes away... who is in charge!

Sovereignty is defined as "Supreme power and authority!" Romans 11:36

We can accept this about God when "life is good", but it's incredibly difficult to accept this truth when life is hard, or when life doesn't make sense!

"When peace like a river attendeth my way... <u>It is well</u> with my soul!"

But what about "When <u>sorrows</u> like sea billows roll..." Can we truly declare,
"Whatever my lot thou hast taught me to say, It is well, it is well with my soul!"

What does Scripture really say about God's sovereignty? Psalm 135

The <u>#7</u> in the Bible means "wholeness, completion, perfection..." In Psalm 135, there are 7 examples given of God's sovereignty!

- 1) God is sovereign in <u>election</u> Vs. 4

 "For the Lord has chosen Jacob for himself, Israel as his own possession."

 Romans 9:6-16... "Jacob I loved, but Esau I hated!"

 Ephesians 1:11 "In him we have obtained an inheritance, having been predestined according to the purpose of him who works all things according to the counsel of his will..."
- 2) God is sovereign over <u>every other god</u> Vs. 5

 "For I know that the LORD is great, & that our Lord is above all gods."
- 3) God is sovereign over <u>His creation</u> Vs. 6-7 "Whatever the LORD pleases, he does, in heaven and on earth, in the seas and all the deeps..."
- 4) God is sovereign over the nations Vs. 8-10a
 "He it was who struck down the firstborn of Egypt... who struck down
 many nations..."
- 5) God is sovereign over kings Vs. 10b-11

 "And killed mighty kings, Sihon, king of the Amorites, and Og, king of Bashan..."
- 6) God is sovereign over <u>outcomes</u> Vs. 12, 14

 "and he gave their land as a heritage, a heritage to his people Israel...

 For the LORD will vindicate his people & have compassion on his servants."
- 7) God is sovereign over <u>all idols</u> Vs. 15-17

 "The idols of the nations are silver and gold, the work of human hands.
 They have mouths... eyes... ears... nor is there any breath in their mouths."

There is only one true God... one sovereign... one king... and He is the LORD!

What are we to do with such knowledge? WLC # 1 – Worship Him (give Him glory – both in word and deed), and enjoy Him forever!

But having supreme power & being on the throne (in complete control), doesn't make someone good! Our God is sovereign, but His sovereignty is never removed from another of His divine attributes... Stay tuned next week!
