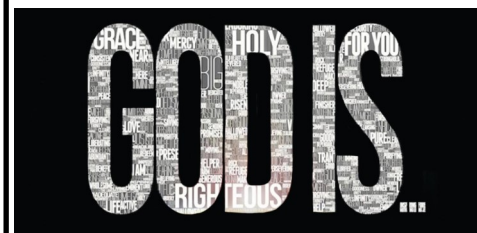


Next week we will be celebrating the Sacrament of Holy Communion at both services 9am & 10:45am.
