I know that for many of us, we would say that this loss of Sabbath is not our fault! We feel that it has been forced upon us by outside sources...

But it's not the world's job to protect our Sabbath, it's a decision we make! Will there be costs involved? Absolutely, but there's a cost either way!

A glimpse into the Toot home – Two working parents, 2 unpredictable jobs, 3 very active children, several time-consuming extracurricular activities, etc.

Life is chaotic in our home! And I know most of you know that same <u>chaos!</u>
But here's also a glimpse into some of the conversations we have as a family:

- How much "activity", "work", "sports" is too much for our family?
   How do we keep the most important things the most important things?
- What do we need to say "no" to, so we can say "yes" to better things?
- What brings glory to God, & prioritizes His work in us & through us?

A few "win" stories from our home, that might inspire you in yours:

- My son got his 1<sup>st</sup> job this summer & he put "No Availability" for Sundays!
- My daughter plays on two travel sports teams, & when she has games on Sunday's, you will see her here at the early service!
- There was "High school prep" soccer practice on Sunday nights during youth group last year, but she prioritized Youth Group over soccer!
- When our Sunday's get packed with activities, we protect <u>Saturday</u> as a day of rest & family time! Our society actually gives us an extra day off!
- When my wife was working every other Sunday, we went to another church on Saturday nights b/c we know the value of worshipping together!
- On my sabbatical, we went to 12 different churches to worship God.
   An extended time of rest for me/us didn't mean a break from worship!

Our lives are busy, but we serve a very busy God too! He created the world & He sustains it in every way! If our plates are full, consider <u>His!</u>

You might say, well "He is God so He can handle it!" Maybe... But even God experienced sabbath, & He makes provisions for us to experience it as well!

Genesis 2:2-3 - "And on the seventh day He rested from all the work that he had done. God blessed the seventh day and made it holy (set apart)."

If God needed a day set apart for rest & worship (declaring it's goodness)... then what do you think we need to keep doing the work He calls us to do?

The reasons I most often hear about why people don't honor the sabbath is "I just don't have the time/I'm too busy!" But if God took the time, & wasn't too busy to take a sabbath, then we can honor & keep the sabbath as well!

The only question is, <u>"Will we?"</u> Will we have the hard conversations? Will we make the tough decisions? Will we prioritize what's most important?
